



Grade Level: Grade 2

Subject: Art

Objective: Students will create a drawing or painting to represent a scene from the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember". They will use their creativity to depict the characters and the jungle setting.

Materials:

- Drawing paper or canvas
- Pencils
- Markers or paints
- Brushes
- Water cups
- Paper towels

Introduction:

- Introduce the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember" to the students.
- Discuss the characters and the jungle setting.
- Explain that the students will be creating a drawing or painting to represent a scene from the story.

Story Comprehension:

- Re-read the story or summarize the main elements for the students.
- Ask the students questions about the story to ensure their comprehension.
- Encourage the students to share their favorite parts of the story.

Discussion and Reflection:

- Display the students' artwork in the classroom or create a class book featuring their drawings and reflections.
