



Grade Level: Grade 1

Subject: Art

Objective:

- Students will create a visual representation of an animal character from the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember."
- Students will practice using different art materials and techniques to create their artwork.

Materials:

- Paper
- Pencils
- Crayons or markers
- Optional: paints, brushes, and water

Introduction:

- Begin by reading the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember" to the students.
- Discuss the different animal characters in the story and their unique qualities.

Story Comprehension:

- Ask the students questions to check their comprehension of the story.
- Example questions: Who are the Jungle Buddyz? How did Scooter feel before the race? How did his friends help him?

Discussion and Reflection:

- Lead a whole-class discussion about the theme of the story – believing in oneself and the importance of friendship and support.
- Ask the students how Scooter's friends helped him and made him feel proud of himself.

Extension Activity:

- Their writing can be displayed alongside their artwork.
