

Grade Level: Grade 2

Subject: Social Studies

Objective: Students will learn about friendship, perseverance, and self-belief through the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember". They will discuss the importance of supporting and encouraging others, even when faced with challenges.

Materials:

- Copy of the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember"
- Chart paper and markers
- Sticky notes
- Pencil crayons / markers
- Extension activity materials (optional)

Introduction:

- 1. Begin the lesson by asking students if they have ever been in a race or competition, and how they felt during that experience.
- 2. Introduce the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember" to the students, highlighting the main characters and their unique qualities.
- 3. Explain that the story is about friendship and how friends can support and encourage each other, even when faced with challenges.

Story Comprehension:

- 1. Read the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember" aloud to the students.
- 2. Pause periodically to ask comprehension questions. For example:
 - Who are the main characters in the story?
 - How did Scooter feel before the race?
 - How did Scooter's friends help and support him?
 - How did Scooter feel after completing the race?
- 3. Encourage students to actively listen to the story and take brief notes on sticky notes about important events or feelings they notice.

Discussion and Reflection:

- 1. Create a chart titled "Friendship, Perseverance, and Self-Belief" on chart paper.
- 2. Ask students to share their sticky notes and take turns sticking them on the chart paper under relevant categories.

- 3. Facilitate a class discussion using the following prompts:
 - Why was Scooter feeling nervous before the race?
 - How did his friends help him feel more confident?
 - How did Scooter persevere and overcome his challenges?
 - Why is it important to support and encourage our friends?
- Can you think of a time when you supported or encouraged someone? How did they feel afterward?
 - How can we apply the lessons from the story to our own lives?

Conclusion:

- 1. Summarize the discussion by emphasizing the importance of friendship, perseverance, and self-belief.
- 2. Remind students that supporting and encouraging others can make a significant impact on their confidence and success.
- 3. Encourage students to remember the story of "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember" as a reminder to be supportive and encouraging to their friends.

Extension Activity:

- 1. Provide students with pencil crayons or markers.
- 2. Ask them to create an illustration or design a friendship card inspired by the story "Jungle Buddyz: A Race to Remember".
- 3. Students can write a supportive message or quote about friendship on the card.
- 4. Optional: Display the friendship cards in the classroom or school hallway as a reminder of the importance of friendship and encouragement.
